

Dear candidate, [not eligible to transition]

In September 2025, we shared information about the new CPA Professional Program. We are writing with an important update based on your program timeline.

### **Transition Eligibility**

At this time, our records indicate that your time limit to complete the current CPA Certification Program will end before December 31, 2028. Noting you will have been provided with the full seven years to complete your certification requirements, **you are not eligible to transition to the new CPA Professional Program that will be introduced in 2027.**

### **What This Means for You**

We strongly encourage you to focus on completing the current program requirements within the time remaining in your program timeline as you can progress toward your CPA designation. This includes:

- CPA PEP education and examinations and
- the CPA Practical Experience Requirements (CPA PER)

### **CPA PEP Final Modules and Exam Offerings**

The final offerings of CPA PEP modules and exams will be as follows:

Planning tip: Provided you have time remaining in your program timeline, there is path to the CFE, with limited opportunity to repeat modules or exams if needed. If you have not yet started Core 1, the earlier you begin, the more flexibility you may have to repeat a module or exam or to take a short break and still complete within the available offerings.

### **Practical Experience (CPA PER)**

You must complete all practical experience requirements under the current program. We encourage you to report your practical experience and submit a CPA Review to your provincial CPA body as soon as possible to determine any outstanding practical experience requirements. You should work closely with your employer to ensure you remain on track to meet all requirements before your program time limit expires.
